### Career goals and aspirations

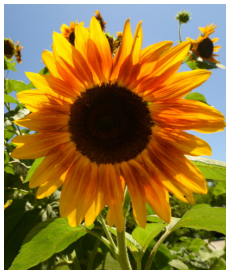

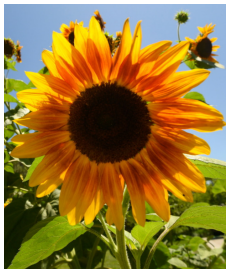

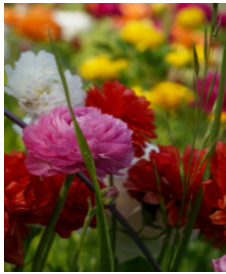
I want to continue working in an archival/library setting so I aspire to get my MA in Library Science.

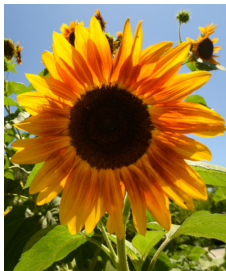
I hope to have a career in accounting in the future, and ideally, I'd like to work for a company that has a strong environmental focus.
